ROV Scholarships Available!

In addition to the MTS scholarships listed above, you may be eligible for the ROV Scholarships, which are for students interested in remotely operated vehicles (ROVs) or

work that supports ROVs. Scholarship available are one at \$5,000, one at \$2,500, two at \$1,250; and three special MATE scholarships, one at \$2,500 and two at \$1,250.

These scholarships are open to all graduate, undergraduate and high school seniors who intend to pursue a college curriculum directed toward a career in marine/ocean sciences or engineering, or a closely related field with an emphasis on ROV technology. The deadline for postmarked applications is April 15, 2008.
