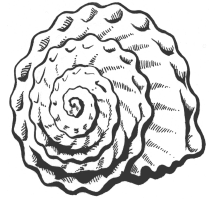

Animal Adaptations-**Key**

You met tide pool animals at the aquarium. Many of these animals have adaptations. Adaptations are body parts and behaviors that help the animal survive.



Draw your favorite tide pool animal. Circle the adaptations the animal uses to get food. Write the names of these adaptations.

Responses may vary. Animals discussed in the class are:

Animal	Adaptations
Sea Snail	mouth, eyes, foot (may also include shell)
Sea Star	Mouth, feet, eyes
Sea Anemone	Mouth, tentacles
Hermit Crab	Mouth, legs, eyes, pinchers

How do these adaptations help the animal get food?

Answers may vary but may include moving to get food, catching food, or eating it.

Imagine that you could have one of the adaptations your favorite tide pool animal has. How would it help you?
