One of the world's biggest research piers, the Ellen Browning Scripps Memorial Pier provides critical information on changes in the coastal Pacific Ocean. Data on ocean conditions and plankton have been taken

from the pier since 1916. In addition to hosting a variety of experiments and small boat launches, Scripps Pier provides a supply of fresh seawater to an array of laboratories and to Birch Aquarium at Scripps.
